ORDER OF VOTE TO SET TAX RATE

“William Hatfield, Commissioner Pct. 1 moved that property **tax rate** be increased by the adoption of a **tax rate** of \$0.3556 which is effectively a 7.69 percent increase in the **tax rate** for fiscal year 2024-2025” Seconded by Jay Ebarb, Commissioner, Pct. 4.

Voting In Favor: Chad Sims, County Judge, William Hatfield, Commissioner, Pct. 1, Zephaniah Timmins, Commissioner, Pct. 2, Phillip Mauldin, Commissioner, Pct. 3, Jay Ebarb, Commissioner, Pct. 4

Voting Against: NONE

(A) “THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR’S TAX RATE,” and

(B) “THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 7.69 PERCENT BY WHICH THE TAX RATE (EXCEEDS THE EFFECTIVE MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS RATE) AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000.00 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$0.70.00.

THEREFORE, WE, THE COMMISSIONERS’ COURT OF HARRISON COUNTY DO HEREBY LEVY AND ADOPT THE TAX RATE ON \$100 VALUATION FOR HARRISON COUNTY FOR FY 2024-2025 TO BE \$0.3559.

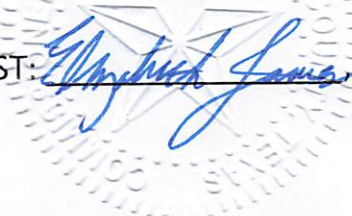
